7 **Section 1. Section 487.082, Florida Statutes, is created**  
8 **to read:**

9 487.082 Products liability actions.- A products liability  
10 action under this part based on a failure to warn may not be  
11 brought or maintained with respect to any pesticide registered  
12 with the United States Environmental Protection Agency under the  
13 Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), 7  
14 U.S.C. ss. 136 et seq., if the label for such pesticide is:

15 (1) Approved by the United States Environmental Protection  
16 Agency;

17           (2) Consistent with the most recent human health risk  
18 assessment performed under FIFRA; or

19           (3) Consistent with the United States Environmental  
20 Protection Agency's carcinogenicity classification of the  
21 pesticide under FIFRA.

23 However, the provisions of this section do not shield from  
24 liability a manufacturer that the United States Environmental  
25 Protection Agency determines knowingly withheld, concealed,  
26 misrepresented, or destroyed material information regarding the  
27 human health risks or carcinogenicity of such pesticide in order  
28 to obtain or maintain approval of its label by the United States  
29 Environmental Protection Agency.

30           **Section 2.** This act shall take effect July 1, 2025.
