69 conviction; fingerprints; palm prints; and a brief description 70 of the crime or crimes committed by the sexual predator offender. A post office box may not be provided in lieu of a 71 physical residential address. The sexual predator shall also 72 73 produce his or her passport, if he or she has a passport, and, 74 if he or she is an alien, shall produce or provide information 75 about documents establishing his or her immigration status. The 76 sexual predator shall also provide information about any 77 professional licenses he or she has.

78 a. Any change that occurs after the sexual predator 79 registers in person at the sheriff's office as provided in this subparagraph in any of the following information related to the 80 sexual predator must be reported as provided in paragraphs (g), 81 82 (i), and (j): permanent, temporary, or transient residence; name; electronic mail addresses; Internet identifiers and each 83 Internet identifier's corresponding website homepage or 84 85 application software name; home and cellular telephone numbers; employment information; and status at an institution of higher 86 87 education.

b. If the sexual predator's place of residence is a motor vehicle, trailer, mobile home, or manufactured home, as those terms are defined in chapter 320, the sexual predator shall also provide to the department written notice of the vehicle identification number (VIN); the license tag number; the registration number; and a description, including color scheme, of the motor vehicle, trailer, mobile home, or manufactured

If a sexual predator's place of residence is a vessel, live-aboard vessel, or houseboat, as those terms are defined in 96 97 chapter 327, the sexual predator shall also provide to the department written notice of the hull identification number; the 98 99 manufacturer's serial number; the name of the vessel, live-100 aboard vessel, or houseboat; the registration number of the 101 vessel, live-aboard vessel, or houseboat; and a description, 102 including color scheme, of the vessel, live-aboard vessel, or 103 houseboat.

104 c. If the sexual predator is enrolled or employed, whether 105 for compensation or as a volunteer, at an institution of higher 106 education in this state, the sexual predator shall also provide 107 to the department the name, address, and county of each 108 institution, including each campus attended, and the sexual 109 predator's enrollment, volunteer, or employment status. The sheriff, the Department of Corrections, or the Department of 110 111 Juvenile Justice shall promptly notify each institution of 112 higher education of the sexual predator's presence and any change in the sexual predator's enrollment, volunteer, or 113 114 employment status.

d. A sexual predator shall report to the department through the department's online system or in person to the sheriff's office within 48 hours after any change in vehicles owned to report those vehicle information changes. <u>A sexual predator who</u> <u>is under the supervision of the Department of Corrections or</u> <u>under the supervision of the Department of Juvenile Justice</u>
