Remove lines 15-133 and insert:

Section 1. Paragraphs (k), (n), and (o) of subsection (2), paragraphs (a), (f), and (g) of subsection (6), subsection (8), and paragraph (a) of subsection (10) of section 775.21, Florida Statutes, are amended to read:

775.21 The Florida Sexual Predators Act.—

(2) DEFINITIONS.—As used in this section, the term:

(k) "Permanent residence" means a place where the person abides, lodges, or resides for 3 or more consecutive days that is the person's home or other place where the person primarily lives. For the purpose of calculating a permanent residence under this paragraph, the first day that a person abides,

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17 lodges, or resides at a place is excluded and each subsequent
18 day is counted. A day includes any part of a calendar day.

19 (n) 1. "Temporary residence" means a place where the person
20 abides, lodges, or resides, including, but not limited to,
21 vacation, business, or personal travel destinations in or out of
22 this state, for a period of 3 or more days in the aggregate
23 during any calendar year that and which is not the person's
24 permanent or transient residence. address or, For a person whose
25 permanent residence is not in this state, the term also includes
26 a place where the person is employed, practices a vocation, or
27 is enrolled as a student for any period of time in this state.

28 2. The term includes an "in-state travel residence," which
29 means a temporary residence in this state established by a
30 person who already has an existing permanent, temporary, or
31 transient residence in this state.

33 For the purpose of calculating a temporary residence under this
34 paragraph, the first day that a person abides, lodges, or
35 resides at a place is excluded and each subsequent day is
36 counted. A day includes any part of a calendar day.

37 (o) "Transient residence" means a county where the person
38 lives, remains, or is located for the purpose of abiding,
39 lodging, or residing for a period of 3 or more days in the
40 aggregate during a calendar year that and which is not the
41 person's permanent or temporary residence address. The term
42 includes, but is not limited to, a place where the person sleeps

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43 or seeks shelter and a location that has no specific street
44 address. For the purpose of calculating a transient residence
45 under this paragraph, the first day that a person lives,
46 remains, or is located in a county for the purpose of abiding,
47 lodging, or residing is excluded and each subsequent day is
48 counted. A day includes any part of a calendar day.

49 (6) REGISTRATION.—

50 (a) A sexual predator shall register with the department
51 through the sheriff's office by providing the following
52 information to the department:

53 1. Name; social security number; age; race; sex; date of
54 birth; height; weight; tattoos or other identifying marks; hair
55 and eye color; photograph; address of permanent or legal
56 residence and address of any current temporary residence, within
57 this state or out of state, including a rural route address and
58 a post office box; if he or she has no permanent or temporary
59 address, any transient residence within this state; address,
60 location or description, and dates of any current or known
61 future temporary residence within this state or out of state;
62 electronic mail addresses; Internet identifiers and each
63 Internet identifier's corresponding website homepage or
64 application software name; home telephone numbers and cellular
65 telephone numbers; employment information, including occupation,
66 business name, employment address, and telephone number; the
67 make, model, color, vehicle identification number (VIN), and
68 license tag number of all vehicles owned; date and place of each

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69 conviction; fingerprints; palm prints; and a brief description
70 of the crime or crimes committed by the sexual predator
71 ~~offender~~. A post office box may not be provided in lieu of a
72 physical residential address. The sexual predator shall also
73 produce his or her passport, if he or she has a passport, and,
74 if he or she is an alien, shall produce or provide information
75 about documents establishing his or her immigration status. The
76 sexual predator shall also provide information about any
77 professional licenses he or she has.

78 a. Any change that occurs after the sexual predator
79 registers in person at the sheriff's office as provided in this
80 subparagraph in any of the following information related to the
81 sexual predator must be reported as provided in paragraphs (g),
82 (i), and (j): permanent, temporary, or transient residence;
83 name; electronic mail addresses; Internet identifiers and each
84 Internet identifier's corresponding website homepage or
85 application software name; home and cellular telephone numbers;
86 employment information; and status at an institution of higher
87 education.

88 b. If the sexual predator's place of residence is a motor
89 vehicle, trailer, mobile home, or manufactured home, as those
90 terms are defined in chapter 320, the sexual predator shall also
91 provide to the department written notice of the vehicle
92 identification number (VIN); the license tag number; the
93 registration number; and a description, including color scheme,
94 of the motor vehicle, trailer, mobile home, or manufactured

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95 home. If a sexual predator's place of residence is a vessel,
96 live-aboard vessel, or houseboat, as those terms are defined in
97 chapter 327, the sexual predator shall also provide to the
98 department written notice of the hull identification number; the
99 manufacturer's serial number; the name of the vessel, live-
100 aboard vessel, or houseboat; the registration number of the
101 vessel, live-aboard vessel, or houseboat; and a description,
102 including color scheme, of the vessel, live-aboard vessel, or
103 houseboat.

104 c. If the sexual predator is enrolled or employed, whether
105 for compensation or as a volunteer, at an institution of higher
106 education in this state, the sexual predator shall also provide
107 to the department the name, address, and county of each
108 institution, including each campus attended, and the sexual
109 predator's enrollment, volunteer, or employment status. The
110 sheriff, the Department of Corrections, or the Department of
111 Juvenile Justice shall promptly notify each institution of
112 higher education of the sexual predator's presence and any
113 change in the sexual predator's enrollment, volunteer, or
114 employment status.

115 d. A sexual predator shall report to the department through
116 the department's online system or in person to the sheriff's
117 office within 48 hours after any change in vehicles owned to
118 report those vehicle information changes. A sexual predator who
119 is under the supervision of the Department of Corrections or
120 under the supervision of the Department of Juvenile Justice

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
