A person or entity who violates this section commits a felony of the third degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082, s. 775.083, or s. 775.084, and shall also be subject to a civil penalty equal to three times the amount contributed. Such penalty shall be paid into the General Revenue Fund of this state. Any penalty imposed against a person that is not an individual jointly and severally attaches to the chair of the entity if the entity does not pay the penalty within 30 days. The Florida Election Commission shall be responsible for determining violations, imposing civil penalties, and collecting any unpaid civil penalties.
