12 (b) A foreign national may not make or offer to make,
 13 directly or indirectly, a contribution or expenditure in
 14 connection with any election held in the state or in connection
 15 with a constitutional amendment proposed by initiative. A
 16 political party, a political committee, an electioneering

17 communications organization, or a candidate may not knowingly
18 accept or solicit directly or indirectly, a contribution from a
19 foreign national in connection with any election held in this
20 state or in connection with a constitutional amendment proposed
21 by initiative. A person or entity who violates this section
22 commits a felony of the third degree, punishable as provided in
23 s. 775.082, s. 775.083, or s. 775.084, and shall also be subject
24 to a civil penalty equal to three times the amount contributed.
25 Such penalty shall be paid into the General Revenue Fund of this
26 state. Any penalty imposed against a person that is not an
27 individual jointly and severally attaches to the chair of the
28 entity if the entity does not pay the penalty within 30 days.
29 The Florida Election Commission shall be responsible for
30 determining violations, imposing civil penalties, and collecting
31 any unpaid civil penalties.

34 322.034 Legal status designation on state-issued driver

36 (1) By July 1, 2026, a driver license or Florida
37 identification card issued new or as a renewal to a qualified
38 application must include the legal status of the licensee or
39 card-holder as either United States citizen or a non-United
40 States citizen as last recorded in the system at the time of
41 issuance or renewal.
