18 **Section 2.** The Legislature finds that it is a public
19 necessity that information received by the Department of State
20 from a Federal agency, another state, or the District of
21 Columbia pursuant to a memorandum of understanding, which is
22 confidential or exempt pursuant to federal law, the laws of the
23 applicable state, or the District of Columbia, be made
24 confidential and exempt from s. 119.07(1), Florida Statutes, and
25 s. 24(a), Article I of the State Constitution. Entering into
26 memoranda of understanding for the purpose of sharing and
27 exchanging information to verify voter registration information
28 is critical to ensuring the accuracy of the statewide voter
29 registration system. Maintaining an accurate statewide voter
30 registration system is critical to fair elections in this state.
31 Without the public records exemption, the department will be
32 unable to receive certain information directly from federal
33 agencies, other states, or the District of Columbia which might
