A bill to be entitled

An act relating to nurse registries; creating s. 400.507, F.S.; providing that certain health care practitioners under contract with a nurse registry are deemed independent contractors for purposes of provider reimbursements under the Medicaid program; providing that such practitioners are not eligible for overtime or holiday pay; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 400.507, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

Motwithstanding any other state or federal law, for purposes of reimbursement under the state Medicaid program, registered nurses, licensed practical nurses, and certified nursing assistants under contract with a nurse registry for the provision of health care services are deemed independent contractors and not employees, and are therefore ineligible for overtime or holiday pay from the nurse registry under the federal Fair Labor Standards Act or any other state or federal law applicable to employees.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2025.
