26 extend the expiration of the declaration for 30 days. A 27 declaration of a public health emergency automatically 28 terminates if it is not timely renewed before its expiration in 29 accordance with this paragraph. An expired declaration may not be renewed. At any time, the Legislature, by concurrent 30 31 resolution, may terminate the public health emergency or any 32 related emergency order. If the public health emergency is terminated by the Legislature, the State Health Officer may not 33 34 declare a substantially similar emergency. 35 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2025.
