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institution or a state university is located must establish at

least one early voting site at such main campus. The parking

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requirements of paragraph (a) do not apply to early voting sites established under this paragraph.

Section 2. Subsection (1) of section 101.71, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

101.71 Polling place.-

- (1) (a) There shall be in each precinct in each county one polling place which shall be accessible to the public on election day and is managed by a board of inspectors and clerk of election. Only one elector shall be allowed to enter any voting booth at a time; no one except inspectors shall be allowed to speak to the elector while casting his or her vote; and no inspector shall speak to or interfere with the elector concerning his or her voting, except to perform the duties as such inspector. Notwithstanding any other provision of this chapter, this section shall be applicable where the computer method of voting is in use, and adequate provision shall be made for the privacy of the elector while casting his or her vote.
- (b) In addition to the polling places established in paragraph (a), there shall be established at least one polling place on any main campus of a Florida College System institution or a state university if such campus is located in the county.

Section 3. Paragraph (e) is added to subsection (3) of section 1001.93, Florida Statutes, to read:

1001.93 Offices of Public Policy Events within the State University System.—

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(3) Each state university within the State University
System must have an Office of Public Policy Events and must
appoint a Director of Public Policy Events who is responsible
for the duties and reporting responsibilities of the office. The
office must, at a minimum:

- (e) Publicize the voting opportunities on campus established by ss. 101.657 and 101.71 through a thorough public awareness campaign including, at a minimum, notifying each student about such voting opportunities through regular and electronic mail, using social media to bring attention to such voting opportunities, and posting signage prominently throughout campus bringing attention to such voting opportunities.
 - Section 4. This act shall take effect July 1, 2025.
