3	Boards of Nursing to produce and distribute the NCLEX
4	examination and test preparation materials in Spanish

7	WHEREAS, the National Council of State Boards of Nursing
8	distributes the National Council Licensure Examination (NCLEX)
9	to Florida and other states in the United States, and
10	WHEREAS, Hispanic and Latino groups are the second-largest
11	racial and ethnic groups in Florida representing 26 percent of
12	the population, and which totals more than 5 million residents,
13	and
14	WHEREAS, the NCLEX is a timed test that determines if a
15	nursing student is adequately prepared to practice as a licensed
16	nurse, and
17	WHEREAS, experience and studies have shown that the NCLEX
18	test results for test takers for whom English is a second
19	language are lower than for test takers for whom English is
20	their first language, and
21	WHEREAS, Canada adopted the NCLEX as its licensing
22	examination in 2012, even though it was only offered in English,
23	and first time success rates on the examination for French-
24	Canadian testers fell from 91 percent to 32 percent; however, in
25	2019, after the NCLEX was provided in French, the passage rates

26 of French-Canadian speaking students on the nursing exam 27 increased substantially, resulting in more available nurses, and 28 WHEREAS, Florida offers licensing examinations in Spanish 29 and other languages for many professions, including for dental 30 hygienists, real estate agents, certified nursing assistants, 31 contractors, food protection managers, cosmetologists, massage 32 therapists, driver license applicants, and certified medical 33 interpreters, and WHEREAS, Florida licensing entities, such as the Electrical 34 35 Contractors Licensing Board, offer special accommodations for 36 speakers of other languages, as do the rules of the Florida 37 Division of Medical Quality Assurance for Clinical Mental Health 38 Counselors, and several medical professions, including 39 Psychology, Medicine, Osteopathy, Podiatry, Optometry, Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology, and Chiropractic Medicine, and 40 41 WHEREAS, according to the Florida Hospital Association, 42 Florida's nursing shortage is expected to reach 59,000 vacancies by 2035, and 43 WHEREAS, one of the goals of the Florida healthcare system 44

44 whereas, one of the goals of the fibrida healthcare system
45 is to close the gap and increase the supply of available nurses
46 for hospitals and other health care facilities, and

WHEREAS, the Florida Legislature has taken steps recently
to increase the supply of nurses in Florida by appropriating
funds through the General Appropriations Act to assist nursing
students and nursing programs, and
