23	for a municipality or a county by the National Weather Service,
24	or the municipality or county is under a mandatory or voluntary
25	evacuation order.
26	<u>(c)</u> "Owner" includes any owner, custodian, or other
27	person in charge of an animal.
28	(d) "Restrain" means to attach a dog to a stationary object
29	or trolley system by way of a chain, rope, tether, leash, cable,
