14 is responding to a passenger ride request for a transportation

16 (2) (a) Except as provided in paragraph (b), a person who
17 willfully violates subsection (1) commits a misdemeanor of the
18 second degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082 or s.
19 775.083.

20 (b) A person who willfully violates subsection (1) during
21 the commission of, or to facilitate the commission of, a
22 separate felony offense commits a felony of the third degree,
23 punishable as provided in s. 775.082, s. 775.083, or s. 775.084.
