Between lines 76 and 77, insert:

(4) For the purposes of this section, the administration of insulin includes sliding scale insulin therapy, to include the calculation of insulin dose based on current blood glucose and the administration of that calculated insulin dose subcutaneously using an insulin pen containing pre-measured doses or a syringe filled with the calculated dose from a vial of insulin.

19 393.506 Administration of medication.—

20 (1) An unlicensed direct service provider may supervise  
21 the self-administration of medication or may administer oral,  
22 transdermal, ophthalmic, otic, rectal, inhaled, enteral, or  
23 topical prescription medications to a client if the unlicensed  
24 direct service provider meets the requirements of this section.  
25 This includes the subcutaneous administration of insulin and  
26 epinephrine through an insulin pen, epinephrine pen, or similar  
27 device designed for self-administration.
