Section 2. The Legislature finds that it is a public necessity that an immaterial, impertinent, or sham matter that would defame or cause unwarranted damage to the good name or reputation of an individual or jeopardize the safety of an individual, and that has been stricken by a court in a noncriminal case, be made confidential and exempt from s.

119.07(1), Florida Statutes, and s. 24(a), Article I of the State Constitution. The Legislature finds that such stricken matters, if they remain in the public record, cause unwarranted and ongoing harm to affected persons and serve no identifiable public purpose. The Legislature further finds that the harm that may result from the release of such stricken matters outweighs any public benefit that may be derived from the disclosure of the stricken matter.

Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2025.
