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An act relating to energy infrastructure investment; amending s. 366.075, F.S.; authorizing the Public Service Commission to establish an experimental mechanism that meets certain requirements to facilitate certain energy infrastructure investment in gas; providing requirements for gas infrastructure investments; authorizing the commission to make certain determinations regarding the experimental mechanism; defining the term "gas"; requiring the commission to adopt rules and propose such rules by a specified date; providing an effective date.

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Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

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Section 1. Subsection (3) is added to section 366.075, Florida Statutes, to read:

366.075 Experimental and transitional rates; experimental

(3) The commission may establish an experimental mechanism to facilitate energy infrastructure investment in gas consistent with the structure set forth in s. 366.96(7) and (8) and the intent of s. 366.91(1). Such gas infrastructure investment may include only such investments that collect, prepare, clean, process, transport, or inject gas as a transportation fuel or for pipeline distribution. The commission shall have discretion to determine whether such mechanism is conducted in an annual proceeding. As used in this subsection, the term "gas" means anaerobically generated biogas, landfill gas, or wastewater
