Between lines 98 and 99, insert:

(8)~~(7)~~ In order to assess the progress in meeting the goal set forth in subsection (3) ~~(2)~~, each county shall, by April 1 each year, provide information to the department regarding its annual solid waste management program and recycling activities.

(a) The information submitted to the department by the county must, at a minimum, include:

1. The amount of municipal solid waste disposed of at solid waste disposal facilities, by type of waste such as yard

13 trash, white goods, clean debris, tires, and unseparated solid
14 waste;

15 2. The amount and type of materials from the municipal
16 solid waste stream that were recycled; and

17 3. The percentage of the population participating in

19 (b) Beginning with the data for the 2012 calendar year,
20 the department shall by July 1 each year post on its website the
21 recycling rates of each county for the prior calendar year.
