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26	Section 2. Section 287.05703, Florida Statutes, is created

28	287.05703 Prohibition of considering race or ethnicity in
29	government contracting
30	(1) As used in this section, the term "awarding body" has
31	the same meaning as in s. 287.05701(1).
32	(2) An awarding body may not:
33	(a) Request documentation of or consider an individual's
34	race or ethnicity when granting contracts or awards.
35	(b) Require or encourage a contractor or grantee to
36	consider the race or ethnicity of an individual to whom the
37	contractor or grantee grants contracts, subcontracts, or awards.
38	(3) Within 60 days after this act takes effect, if an
39	awarding body has rules or regulations providing for the
40	consideration of an individual's race or ethnicity when granting
41	contracts or awards, the awarding body shall submit a notice of
42	proposed rulemaking removing all such references. Within 180
43	days after this act takes effect, the awarding body shall adopt
44	a final rule removing all such references.
45	Section 3. If any state department or agency or any local
46	government governing body has procurement goals based on race or
47	ethnicity established by rule or regulation, respectively, for
48	disadvantaged businesses or any other businesses in
49	disadvantaged communities, such goals shall be reduced by the
50	proportion of contracts or awards granted in the last fiscal

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51	year based on such preferences relative to all other contracting
52	preferences, unless the department, agency, or governing body
53	proposes an amendment to any such rule or regulation changing
54	such goals within 60 days after this act takes effect.
55	Section 4. Any law, charter amendment, ordinance,
56	resolution, rule, regulation, or policy adopted by this state or
57	a local government that violates this act is prohibited and
58	void.
59	Section 5. This act does not apply to any existing state
60	or local government contracting goals or preferences:
61	(1) Provided to small, women-owned, or veteran-owned
62	businesses.
63	(2) Provided to disadvantaged businesses if such goal or
64	preference is required for this state or a local government to
65	be awarded a federal grant or contract.
66	(3) That are not based on race or ethnicity.
67	Section 6. This act shall take effect on the 60th day
68	after adjournment sine die of the session of the Legislature in
69	which enacted.
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
