19	licensed as a vendor, manufacturer, bottler, or distributor
20	under the Beverage Law. When a licensed vendor purchases or
21	acquires alcoholic beverages for the purpose of resale, the
22	vendor may have an ownership interest in the production of such
23	beverages. Alcoholic beverages may be sold on the licensed
24	premises if production, distribution, and retail sales are

beverages by vendors from vendors shall be strictly limited to 26 27 purchases between members of a pool buying group for which the 28 initial purchase of the alcoholic beverages was ordered by a 29 pool buying agent as a single transaction. No vendor shall be a 30 member of more than one cooperative or pool buying group at any 31 time. No vendor shall import, or engage in the importation of, any alcoholic beverages from places beyond the limits of the 32 33 state.
