| 19 | resolution aerial imagery, including orthoimagery and oblique |

| 21 | may provide for co-collection of data by aerial imagery, LiDAR, |
| 22 | and other methods. Data collection must be in accordance with |
| 23 | United States Geological Survey recommendations for |
| 24 | technologies, standards, and specifications. |
| 25 | (3) The Department of Transportation, in coordination with |
| 26 | the workgroup, shall review state statutes and policies related |
| 27 | to geospatial data sharing throughout state government and make |
| 28 | recommendations to the President of the Senate and the Speaker |
| 29 | of the House of Representatives by November 15, 2025, for any |
