Section 1. Present paragraphs (a) through (d) of subsection (3) of section 365.171, Florida Statutes, are redesignated as paragraphs (b) through (e), respectively, a new paragraph (a) is added to that subsection, and present paragraphs (c) and (d) of that subsection are amended, to read:

365.171 Emergency communications state plan.-

- (3) DEFINITIONS.—As used in this section, the term:
- (a) "First responder" means any of the following persons who is either a full-time paid employee, a part-time paid employee, or an unpaid volunteer:
- 1. A 911 public safety telecommunicator, as defined in s. 401.465.
 - 2. A correctional officer, as defined in s. 943.10(2).
- 3. An emergency medical technician or paramedic, as those terms are defined in s. 401.23.
- 4. A federal law enforcement officer, as defined in s. 901.1505(1).
 - 5. A firefighter, as defined in s. 633.102.
 - 6. A law enforcement officer, as defined in s. 943.10(1).
 - (d) (e) "Public agency" means the state and any city,

county, city and county, municipal corporation, chartered organization, public district, or public authority located in whole or in part within this state which provides, or has authority to provide, <u>first responder firefighting</u>, law enforcement, ambulance, medical, or other emergency services.

(e) (d) "Public safety agency" means a functional division of a public agency providing first responder which provides firefighting, law enforcement, medical, or other emergency services.

Section 2. Paragraph (c) of subsection (1) of section 401.465, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:
