(b) The corporation is authorized to create not-for-profit corporate subsidiaries that are organized under the provisions of chapter 617 upon the prior approval of <u>its board of directors</u> the Board of Governors, as necessary, to fulfill its mission.

33 (4) The articles of incorporation of the corporation or 34 any authorized and approved subsidiary must be approved in a 35 written agreement by the Board of Governors. The agreement and 36 the articles of incorporation must shall:

(a) Provide that the corporation and any authorized and
approved subsidiary shall provide equal employment opportunities
for all persons regardless of race, color, religion, gender,
national origin, age, handicap, or marital status.

(b) Provide that the corporation and any authorized and
approved subsidiary are subject to the public records and
meeting requirements of s. 24, Art. I of the State Constitution.

(c) Provide that all officers, directors, and employees of
the corporation and any authorized and approved subsidiary shall
be governed by the code of ethics for public officers and

Three state university representatives. 66 67 Ten Nine public representatives who are neither state 4.5. 68 university employees nor state employees. 69 (b) The Governor, the President of the Senate, and the 70 Speaker of the House of Representatives shall each make one 71 initial appointment of a state university representative to the 72 board of directors. Each director who is a representative of a state university shall be appointed for an initial term of 3 73 74 years. The Governor shall make three initial appointments of 75 public representatives to the board of directors. The President

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76 of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives 77 shall each make two initial appointments of public 78 representatives to the board of directors. The chair of the Board of Trustees of the University of West Florida shall make 79 80 two initial appointments of public representatives to the board 81 of directors. The Board of Trustees of the University of West 82 Florida shall make one appointment of a public representative to 83 the board of directors. Each director who is a representative of 84 the public shall be appointed to serve an initial term of 2 85 years.

86 (9) The <u>corporation</u> Board of Trustees of the University of 87 West Florida shall annually certify to the Governor, the 88 President of the Senate, the Speaker of the House of 89 Representatives, and the Board of Governors that the corporation 90 and its authorized subsidiaries are complying with the 91 requirements of this section and are acting in the best 92 interests of the state.

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private universities.
