17 self-betterment programs and courses in the department while he  
18 or she is incarcerated. The guidelines shall require the  
19 commission to aggravate or aggregate each consecutive sentence  
20 in establishing the presumptive parole release date. Factors  
21 used in arriving at the salient factor score and the severity of  
22 offense behavior category may ~~shall~~ not be applied as  
23 aggravating circumstances. If the sentencing judge files a  
24 written objection to the parole release of an inmate as provided  
25 for in s. 947.1745(6), such objection may be used by the  
26 commission as a basis to extend the presumptive parole release  
27 date.

28 (2) At least once a year, the commission shall review the  
29 objective parole guidelines and make any revisions considered  
30 necessary by virtue of statistical analysis of commission  
31 actions, which analysis uses acceptable research and  
32 methodology. The commission shall provide each statistical  
33 analysis to the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the  
34 House of Representatives upon completion.

35 **Section 2.** This act shall take effect July 1, 2025.
