(1) The regulation of auxiliary containers is expressly preempted to the state. A local government, local governmental
~~government~~ agency, or state governmental agency may not enact or
enforce any rule, regulation, or ordinance regarding the use,
disposition, sale, prohibition, restriction, or tax of such
auxiliary containers unless explicitly permitted by statute.

(2) Rules, regulations, or ordinances restricting the use of glass auxiliary containers within the boundaries of any public beach are explicitly permitted.

(3) The Division of Recreation and Parks of the Department of Environmental Protection may adopt rules regulating auxiliary containers within state parks consistent with its grant of authority in s. 258.004,
