Section 1. Present paragraphs (b) and (c) of subsection (2) of section 810.08, Florida Statutes, are redesignated as paragraphs (c) and (d), respectively, and a new paragraph (b) is added to that subsection, to read:

810.08 Trespass in structure or conveyance.-

> (b) If the offense occurs in a structure being used for a large, ticketed event wherein attendance exceeds 5,000 persons, the trespass in a structure or conveyance is a felony of the third degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082, s. 775.083, or s. 775.084.

Section 2. Paragraph (d) of subsection (3) of section 921.0022, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:
