A bill to be entitled

An act relating to fees; amending s. 585.713, F.S.; requiring dog breeders to pay registration and renewal fees in amounts to be determined by the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services; providing a limit on such fees; requiring the department to notify a certificateholder of the annual renewal fee by a specified date; providing a contingent effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsections (1), (2), and (3) of section 585.713, Florida Statutes, as created by SB 1830, 2025 Regular Session, is amended to read:

585.713 Certificate of registration and inspection.-

- (1) Each dog breeder within this state must apply to the department, on forms supplied by the department, for a certificate of registration. Each application for a certificate of registration must be accompanied by a registration fee in an amount determined by the department, not to exceed \$500.
- (2) The certificate of registration, the structure of which shall be determined by the department, must be renewed annually on its anniversary date upon satisfactory showing that the applicant has complied with this part and the rules of the department and has paid the annual renewal fee in an amount determined by the department, not to exceed \$500.
- (3) The department shall provide to each dog breeder subject to this section a written notice and renewal form 60 days before the annual renewal date, informing the dog breeder

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of the certificate of registration renewal date <u>and the</u> applicable fee.

Section 2. This act shall take effect on the same date that SB 1830 or similar legislation takes effect, if such legislation is adopted in the same legislative session or an extension thereof and becomes a law.
