A bill to be entitled

An act relating to education in correctional facilities for licensed professions; amending s.

944.801, F.S.; requiring the Correctional Education Program to develop a plan in coordination with the boards of professions within the Department of Business and Professional Regulation, or the department when there is no board, for inmates to take classes for credit toward licensure requirements; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Paragraph (m) is added to subsection (3) of section 944.801, Florida Statutes, to read:

944.801 Education for state prisoners.-

- (3) The responsibilities of the Correctional Education Program shall be to:
- (m) Design and implement a plan, in coordination with the relevant professional boards within the Department of Business and Professional Regulation, or the Department of Business and Professional Regulation when there is no board, to ensure that inmates in a correctional institution who take classes that meet the necessary curriculum requirements as determined by the applicable law and rules for those professions shall receive
