 2 An act relating to immigration enforcement assistance
 3 agreements; amending s. 908.11, F.S.; requiring each
 4 law enforcement agency operating a detention facility
 5 to enter into a specified agreement with the United
 6 States Immigration and Customs Enforcement; requiring
 7 certain law enforcement agencies to report specified
 8 information quarterly to the Department of Law
 9 Enforcement; providing an effective date.

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 11 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

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 13 **Section 1. Subsection (2) of section 908.11, Florida**
 14 **Statutes, is renumbered as subsection (3) and amended, and a new**
 15 **subsection (2) is added to that section, to read:**

16 908.11 Immigration enforcement assistance agreements;
 17 reporting requirement.—

18 (2) By January 1, 2026, each law enforcement agency
 19 operating a detention facility must enter into a written
 20 agreement with the United States Immigration and Customs
 21 Enforcement to participate in the immigration program
 22 established under s. 287(g) of the Immigration and Nationality
 23 Act, 8 U.S.C. s. 1357. This subsection does not require a law
 24 enforcement agency to participate in a particular program model.

27 | ~~required under subsection (1),~~ Each law enforcement agency
