A bill to be entitled

An act relating to immigration enforcement assistance agreements; amending s. 908.11, F.S.; requiring each law enforcement agency operating a detention facility to enter into a specified agreement with the United States Immigration and Customs Enforcement; requiring certain law enforcement agencies to report specified information quarterly to the Department of Law Enforcement; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

- Section 1. Subsection (2) of section 908.11, Florida

 Statutes, is renumbered as subsection (3) and amended, and a new subsection (2) is added to that section, to read:
- 908.11 Immigration enforcement assistance agreements; reporting requirement.—
- (2) By January 1, 2026, each law enforcement agency operating a detention facility must enter into a written agreement with the United States Immigration and Customs

 Enforcement to participate in the immigration program established under s. 287(g) of the Immigration and Nationality

 Act, 8 U.S.C. s. 1357. This subsection does not require a law enforcement agency to participate in a particular program model.

(3) (2) Beginning no later than October 1, 2022, and until

the law enforcement agency enters into the written agreement required under subsection (1), Each law enforcement agency operating a county detention facility not in compliance with this section must notify the Department of Law Enforcement quarterly of the status of the required such written agreement and any reason for noncompliance with this section, if applicable.
