18	other incentives to landowners to continue and improve land uses

21	(b) The commission shall ensure that any agreement for
22	environmental services entered into requires the landowner to
23	manage the land in a manner that improves or enhances the land
24	beyond what is required under any other agreement or contract
25	the landowner may have with the state.

27	management funds received pursuant to s. 380.095 for this
