6 Remove lines 38-105 and insert:

7 (2) (a) A meeting or a portion of a meeting of the Social
 8 Work Licensure Compact Commission or the executive committee or
 9 other committee of the commission, established in Article X of
 10 s. 491.022, at which matters specifically exempted from
 11 disclosure by federal or state law is exempt from s. 286.011 and
 12 s. 24(b), Art. I of the State Constitution.

13 (b) Recordings, minutes, and records generated during an
 14 exempt meeting or portion of such a meeting are exempt from s.
 15 119.07(1) and s. 24(a), Art. I of the State Constitution.

16 (3) This section is subject to the Open Government Sunset

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17 Review Act in accordance with s. 119.15 and shall stand repealed
18 on October 2, 2030, unless reviewed and saved from repeal
19 through reenactment by the Legislature.

20 **Section 2.** (1) The Legislature finds that it is a public
21 necessity that a social worker's personal identifying
22 information, other than the social worker's name, licensure
23 status, or licensure number, obtained from the data system, as
24 described in Article XI of s. 491.022, Florida Statutes, and
25 held by the Department of Health or the Board of Clinical Social
26 Work, Marriage and Family Therapy, and Mental Health Counseling
27 be made exempt from s. 119.07(1), Florida Statutes, and s.
28 24(a), Article I of the State Constitution. Protection of such
29 information is required under the Social Work Licensure
30 Interstate Compact, which a state must adopt in order to become
31 a member state of the compact. Without the public records
32 exemption, this state will be unable to effectively implement
33 and administer the compact.

34 (2) (a) The Legislature finds that it is a public necessity
35 that any meeting of the Social Work Licensure Compact Commission
36 or the executive committee or other committee of the commission
37 held as provided in s. 491.022, Florida Statutes, in which
38 matters specifically exempted from disclosure by federal or
39 state law are discussed be made exempt from s. 286.011, Florida
40 Statutes, and s. 24(b), Article I of the State Constitution.

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41 (b) The Social Work Licensure Interstate Compact requires
42 the closure of any meeting, or any portion of a meeting, of the
43 Social Work Licensure Compact Commission or the
