receipt, investigation, and determination of complaints received			
by such agency from any person, which must be the procedure for			
investigating a complaint against a law enforcement or			
correctional officer and for determining whether to proceed with			
disciplinary action or to file disciplinary charges,			
notwithstanding any other law or ordinance to the contrary. $\underline{\mathtt{A}}$			
complaint may be submitted anonymously. However, such complaint			
may not be investigated unless it is facially valid, meaning			
that if the allegations in the complaint are taken as true, the			
complaint would constitute grounds for discipline. A complaint
