(a) Must provide students with access to a certified school counselor. The school counselor shall provide students with information about the eligibility requirements for each Florida Bright Futures Scholarship award and the awards for which the student is on track to be eligible for.

(b) Must include a comprehensive outreach campaign through social media and the school's website. The campaign may include the success stories of students who were awarded a scholarship through the program, application tips, and question and answer sessions for students and parents.
