Referendum.-On or before December 31, 2026, the 28 Supervisor of Elections of St. Lucie County shall conduct a 29 referendum by mail ballot of the landowners within the district 30 voting in the same manner by which the district's governing board is elected. The referendum question shall be placed on the 31 32 ballot in substantially the following form: 33 Shall the maximum annual maintenance tax that may be levied 34 35 by the North St. Lucie River Water Control District be increased from \$25 to \$50 per acre, provided that the 36 37 amount levied may not increase by more than 10 percent in 38 any one year? 39 () YES. 40) NO. (Section 3.
