2	An act relating to Duval County; providing space and
3	seating requirements for the issuance of special
4	alcoholic beverage licenses to event centers;
5	providing an exception to general law; providing
6	boundaries; providing an effective date.

8	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:
9	
10	Section 1. Notwithstanding s. 561.20, Florida Statutes,
11	the Division of Alcoholic Beverages and Tobacco of the
12	Department of Business and Professional Regulation may issue
13	special alcoholic beverage licenses to event centers in the
14	Urban Transition Area North of Park Street which have an
15	occupancy between 1,100 and 1,400 people and derive no less than
16	51 percent of annual gross income from the sale of event center
17	tickets and food and nonalcoholic beverages that are prepared,
18	served, and consumed on such premises. For the purposes of this
19	act, the term "event center" means a facility that routinely
20	hosts events for which entrance is by customers who have
21	purchased tickets, including, but not limited to, musical
22	concerts and art shows; hosts events sponsored or organized by
23	nonprofit organizations; and otherwise does not market itself
24	primarily as a food service establishment. The Division of
25	Alcoholic Beverages and Tobacco of the Department of Business
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26	and Professional Regulation may revoke or suspend any such
27	license for violations of the Beverage Law and regulations of
28	this state not inconsistent herewith.
29	Section 2. For the purposes of this act, the "Urban
30	Transition Area North of Park Street" shall mean the area
31	described as:
32	
33	All of lots 3, 4, and 9, the north 60.0 feet of lot 8, the
34	south 10.0 feet of the west 10.0 feet of lot 2, and the
35	south 10.0 feet of lot 10, block 29, the Chamberlain and
36	Barretts subdivision, according to the plat thereof
37	recorded in plat book 1, pages 117 and 120 of the former
38	public records of Duval County, Florida, plus a narrow
39	strip of land immediately south of the southerly line of
40	lot 4 and the northerly 60.0 feet (less and except portion
41	lying in road right of way) of lot 8, of said block 29,
42	more particularly described as follows:
43	
44	Begin at the northeast corner of said lot 3, the said
45	point of beginning being south 21°-00'-00" west, 120.0
46	feet, and measure along the westerly line of Park
47	Street from the southerly line of Post Street; thence
48	continue south 21°-00'-00" west, 120.0 feet along said
49	westerly line of Park Street; thence westerly along
50	the southerly face of an existing four-story brick

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51	building a distance of 134.0 feet, more or less, to
52	the southwest corner of said four-story brick
53	building; thence northerly along the westerly line of
54	said four-story brick building 0.38 feet; thence
55	westerly to the easterly line of Margaret Street, said
56	point being north 68°-42'-30" west 194.68 feet from a
57	point in the westerly line of Park Street that is
58	240.0 feet southerly of the southerly line of Post
59	Street; thence north 15°-40'-30" west, 150.05 feet
60	along the easterly line of said Margaret Street;
61	thence south 68°-43'-50" east, 124.29 feet' thence
62	north 21°-00'-00" east, 10.0 feet; thence north 68°-
63	43'-50" east, 50.0 feet; thence south 21°-00'-00"
64	west, 10.0 feet; thence south 68°-40'-50" east, 110.0
65	feet to the point of beginning.
66	Section 3. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
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
