The Authority shall be estopped in any future proceeding conducted pursuant to section 34 180.03 or section 180.04, Florida Statutes, by the City of St. 35 Cloud, or any action arising therefrom, from asserting or 36 37 claiming the willingness and ability to provide potable water or 38 wastewater service to:
