Amendment

Remove lines 102-123 and insert:

2. Once 17,598 qualified electors reside within the district, two governing board members shall be persons who are qualified electors of the district and who were elected by the qualified electors, and three governing board members shall be persons elected by the landowners.

3. Once 26,397 qualified electors reside within the district, three governing board members shall be persons who are qualified electors of the district and who were elected by the qualified electors and two governing board members shall be persons who were elected by the landowners.

Amendment No.

17 4. Once 35,196 qualified electors reside within the
18 district, four governing board members shall be persons who are
19 qualified electors of the district and who were elected by the
20 qualified electors and one governing board member shall be a
21 person who was elected by the landowners.

22 5. Once 39,595 qualified electors reside within the
23 district, all five governing board members shall be persons who
24 are qualified electors of the district and who were elected by
25 the qualified electors.

26 Nothing in this sub-subparagraph is intended to require an
27 election prior to the expiration of an existing board member's
28 term.
