16	Section 1. Section 490.017, Florida Statutes, is created to

22	which any of the following information is discussed is exempt

24	(a) Noncompliance of a member state with its obligations
25	under the compact;
26	(b) The employment, compensation, discipline, or other
27	matters, practices, or procedures related to specific employees

54	provide a full and accurate summary of actions taken, and the
55	reasons therefor, including a description of the views
56	expressed. All documents considered in connection with an action
57	must be identified in such minutes. All minutes and documents of
58	a closed meeting must remain under seal, subject to release only

77	requires the closure of any portion of a meeting of the
78	Interstate Compact for School Psychologists Commission or its

81 0	discuss certain sensitive and confidential subject matters as
82 3	specified in s. 490.017(1), Florida Statutes. In the absence of
83 3	a public meetings exemption, this state would be prohibited from
84	becoming a member state of the compact. Thus, this state would
85 3	be unable to effectively and efficiently administer the compact.
86	(3) The Legislature also finds that it is a public

89	Florida Statutes, that is exempt from public meetings
90	requirements be made exempt from s. 119.07(1), Florida Statutes,
91	and s. 24(a), Article I of the State Constitution. Release of
92	such information would negate the public meetings exemption. As
93	such, the Legislature finds that the public records exemption is
94	a public necessity.
95	Section 3. This act shall take effect on the same date that
96	SB 434 or similar legislation takes effect, if such legislation
97	is adopted in the same legislative session or an extension
98	thereof and becomes a law.
