8 more than 30 days in any 6-month period within the jurisdiction
9 of a county with a population of 1.5 million or more, excluding
10 any time the vessel is anchored overnight within the boundaries
11 of a marked mooring field or any time the vessel is anchored
12 overnight for the purpose of completing permitted marine
13 construction, installation, or maintenance work;

15 **327.4108, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:**

18 (1) The following densely populated urban areas, which
19 have narrow state waterways, residential docking facilities, and
20 significant recreational boating traffic, are designated as and
21 shall be considered to be grandfathered-in anchoring limitation
22 areas, within which a person may not anchor a vessel at any time
23 during the period between one-half hour after sunset and one-
24 half hour before sunrise, except as provided in subsections (4)
25 and (5):

38 **Section 3. Paragraph (a) of subsection (1) of section**
39 **327.4109, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:**

40 327.4109 Anchoring or mooring prohibited; exceptions;

42 (1) (a) The owner or operator of a vessel or floating
43 structure may not anchor or moor such that the nearest approach
44 of the anchored or moored vessel or floating structure is:

45 1. Within 150 feet of any public or private marina, boat
46 ramp, boatyard, or other public vessel launching or loading
47 facility;

48 2. Within 500 feet of a superyacht repair facility. For
49 purposes of this subparagraph, the term "superyacht repair
50 facility" means a facility that services or repairs a yacht with
51 a water line of 120 feet or more in length; or

52 3. Within 300 ~~100~~ feet outward from the marked boundary of
53 a public mooring field or a lesser distance if approved by the
54 commission upon request of a local government within which the
55 mooring field is located. The commission may adopt rules to
56 implement this subparagraph.

57 **Section 4.** This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
