14	119.071, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

18	(d)1. For purposes of this paragraph, the term:
19	a. "Home addresses" means the dwelling location at which
20	an individual resides and includes the physical address, mailing
21	address, street address, parcel identification number, plot
22	identification number, legal property description, neighborhood
23	name and lot number, GPS coordinates, and any other descriptive
24	property information that may reveal the home address.
25	b. "Judicial assistant" means a court employee assigned to
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26 the following class codes: 8140, 8150, 8310, and 8320.

27 c. "Telephone numbers" includes home telephone numbers, 28 personal cellular telephone numbers, personal pager telephone 29 numbers, and telephone numbers associated with personal 30 communications devices.

2.a. The home addresses, telephone numbers, dates of 31 32 birth, and photographs of active or former sworn law enforcement personnel or of active or former civilian personnel employed by 33 a law enforcement agency, including correctional and 34 35 correctional probation officers, personnel of the Department of 36 Children and Families whose duties include the investigation of 37 abuse, neglect, exploitation, fraud, theft, or other criminal 38 activities, personnel of the Department of Health whose duties 39 are to support the investigation of child abuse or neglect, and 40 personnel of the Department of Revenue or local governments 41 whose responsibilities include revenue collection and 42 enforcement or child support enforcement; the names, home 43 addresses, telephone numbers, photographs, dates of birth, and places of employment of the spouses and children of such 44 45 personnel; and the names and locations of schools and day care facilities attended by the children of such personnel are exempt 46 from s. 119.07(1) and s. 24(a), Art. 348 <u>z. The home addresses, telephone numbers, dates of birth,</u> 349 <u>and photographs of sexual assault counselors, as defined in s.</u> 350 <u>90.5035(1)(b), are exempt from s. 119.07(1) and s. 24(a), Art. I</u>

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351 of the State Constitution. This sub-subparagraph is subject to 352 the Open Government Sunset Review Act in accordance with s. 353 <u>119.15 and shall stand repealed on October 2, 2030, unless</u> 354 reviewed and saved from repeal through reenactment by the 355 Legislature.

356 3. An agency that is the custodian of the information 357 specified in subparagraph 2. and that is not the employer of the 358 officer, employee, justice, judge, or other person specified in 359 subparagraph 2. must maintain the exempt status of that information only if the officer, employee, justice, judge, other 360 person, or employing agency of the designated employee submits a 361 362 written and notarized request for maintenance of the exemption 363 to the custodial agency. The request must state under oath the statutory basis for the individual's exemption request and 364 365 confirm the individual's status as a party eligible for exempt 366 status.

367 4.a. A county property appraiser, as defined in s. 368 192.001(3), or a county tax collector, as defined in s. 369 192.001(4), who receives a written and notarized request for 370 maintenance of the exemption pursuant to subparagraph 3. must 371 comply by removing the name of the individual with exempt status 372 and the instrument number or Official Records book and page 373 number identifying the property with the exempt status from all 374 publicly available records maintained by the property appraiser 375 or tax collector. For written requests received on or before

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376 July 1, 2021, a county property appraiser or county tax 377 collector must comply with this sub-subparagraph by October 1, 378 2021. A county property appraiser or county tax collector may not remove the street address, legal description, or other 379 380 information identifying real property within the agency's records so long as a name or personal information otherwise 381 382 exempt from inspection and copying pursuant to this section is 383 not associated with the property or otherwise displayed in the 384 public records of the agency.

b. Any information restricted from public display,
inspection, or copying under sub-subparagraph a. must be
provided to the individual whose information was removed.

5. An officer, an employee, a justice, a judge, or other 388 389 person specified in subparagraph 2. may submit a written request 390 for the release of his or her exempt information to the 391 custodial agency. The written request must be notarized and must 392 specify the information to be released and the party authorized 393 to receive the information. Upon receipt of the written request, 394 the custodial agency must release the specified information to 395 the party authorized to receive such information.

396 6. The exemptions in this paragraph apply to information
397 held by an agency before, on, or after the effective date of the
398 exemption.

399 7. Information made exempt under this paragraph may be400 disclosed pursuant to s. 28.2221 to a title insurer authorized

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401 pursuant to s. 624.401 and its affiliates as defined in s. 402 624.10; a title insurance agent or title insurance agency as 403 defined in s. 626.841(1) or (2), respectively; or an attorney 404 duly admitted to practice law in this state and in good standing 405 with The Florida Bar.

406 8. The exempt status of a home address contained in the 407 Official Records is maintained only during the period when a 408 protected party resides at the dwelling location. Upon 409 conveyance of real property after October 1, 2021, and when such 410 real property no longer constitutes a protected party's home address as defined in sub-subparagraph 1.a., the protected party 411 412 must submit a written request to release the removed information 413 to the county recorder. The written request to release the 414 removed information must be notarized, must confirm that a 415 protected party's request for release is pursuant to a conveyance of his or her dwelling location, and must specify the 416 417 Official Records book and page, instrument number, or clerk's 418 file number for each document containing the information to be 419 released.

9. Upon the death of a protected party as verified by a certified copy of a death certificate or court order, any party can request the county recorder to release a protected decedent's removed information unless there is a related request on file with the county recorder for continued removal of the decedent's information or unless such removal is otherwise

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prohibited by statute or by court order. The written request to release the removed information upon the death of a protected

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428 party must attach the certified copy of a death certificate or 429 court order and must be notarized, must confirm the request for 430 release is due to the death of a protected party, and must 431 specify the Official Records book and page number, instrument 432 number, or clerk's file number for each document containing the 433 information to be released. A fee may not be charged for the 434 release of any document pursuant to such request.

435 Section 2. The Legislature finds that it is a public 436 necessity that the home addresses, telephone numbers, dates of 437 birth, and photographs of sexual assault counselors, as defined in s. 90.5035(1), Florida Statutes, be made exempt from s. 438 439 119.07(1), Florida Statutes, and s. 24(a), Article I of the 440 State Constitution. Sexual assault counselors regularly support 441 individuals who are victims of crime by offering emotional 442 assistance, providing resources, and helping the victims 443 navigate the legal process. Sexual assault counselors often work 444 closely with law enforcement agencies, government organizations, 445 and other entities to ensure that the victims' rights are upheld and the victims' needs are addressed. The personal identifying 446 447 and location information of sexual assault counselors is 448 frequently documented in police reports or other official 449 records that are provided to a defendant and his or her legal 450 counsel as part of the discovery process. Those documents are

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451	subject to public records requests, making the sexual assault
452	counselors' personal identifying and location information
453	readily available. The release of this information has led to
454	sexual assault counselors becoming targets of harassment,
455	threats, or retaliation from individuals connected to the cases
456	on which the sexual assault counselors work. The Legislature
457	finds that the release of such personal identifying and location
458	information could place sexual assault counselors in danger of
459	being stalked or physically or emotionally harmed by a defendant
460	or other individual. Therefore, the Legislature finds that the
461	harm that may result from the release of such personal
462	identifying and location information outweighs any public
463	benefit that may be derived from the disclosure of the
464	information.
465	Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2025.

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
