| 16 | (c) A person is ineligible for a license under this |
| 17 | section if he or she: |
| 18 | 1. Has a complaint, an allegation, or an investigation |
| 19 | pending before a licensing entity in another state, the District |
| 20 | of Columbia, or a possession or territory of the United States; |
| 21 | 2. Has been convicted of or pled nolo contendere to, |
| 22 | regardless of adjudication, any felony or misdemeanor related to |
| 23 | the practice of a health care profession; |
| 24 | 3. Has had a health care provider license revoked or |
| 25 | suspended by another state, the District of Columbia, or a |
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| 26 | territory of the United States, or has voluntarily surrendered |
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| 27 | any such license in lieu of having disciplinary action taken |
| 28 | against the license; or |
| 29 | 4. Has not graduated from a dental college or school or |
