13 (3) AUTOMATED DRIVING SYSTEM.—The hardware and software
14 that are collectively capable of performing the entire dynamic
15 driving task of an autonomous vehicle on a sustained basis,

16 regardless of whether it is limited to a specific operational
17 design domain. The term:

18 (b) "Dynamic driving task" means all of the real-time
19 operational and tactical functions required to operate a vehicle
20 in on-road traffic within its specific operational design
21 domain, if any, excluding strategic functions such as trip
22 scheduling; provision of event-based information, advice,
23 instruction, or revised goals; and selection of destinations and
24 waypoints.

25 (41) MICROMOBILITY DEVICE.—A motorized transportation
26 device designed for individual use which is typically 20 to 36
27 inches in width and 50 pounds or less in weight and which
28 operates at a speed of typically less than 15 miles per hour but
29 no more than 28 miles per hour. This term includes both a human-
30 powered and a nonhuman-powered device such as a bicycle,
31 electric bicycle, motorized scooter, or any other device that is
32 owned by an individual or part of a shared fleet ~~Any motorized~~
33 ~~transportation device made available for private use by~~
34 ~~reservation through an online application, website, or software~~
35 ~~for point-to-point trips and which is not capable of traveling~~
