**Section 6. Section 316.88, Florida Statutes, is created to  
read:**

316.88 Creation of a wake on streets or highways.—A person  
may not operate a motor vehicle, vessel, or any other conveyance  
at a speed that creates an excessive wake on a flooded or  
inundated street or highway.

**Section 7. Subsection (109) of section 316.003, Florida  
Statutes, is amended to read:**
