 2 An act relating to chemical additives in food
 3 products; creating s. 500.454, F.S.; beginning on a
 4 specified date, prohibiting a food establishment from
 5 manufacturing, selling, or distributing food that
 6 contains specified chemical additives; providing
 7 penalties; providing an effective date.

9 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

 11 **Section 1. Section 500.454, Florida Statutes, is created**
 12 **to read:**

13 500.454 Prohibited chemical additives; penalties.-

14 (1) Beginning January 1, 2028, a food establishment may
 15 not manufacture, sell, or distribute a food that contains any of
 16 the following chemical additives:

- 17 (a) Brominated vegetable oil.
- 18 (b) Potassium bromate.
- 19 (c) Propylparaben.
- 20 (d) Red dye 3.
- 21 (e) Blue dye 1.
- 22 (f) Yellow dye 5.
- 23 (g) Benzidine.
- 24 (h) Butylated hydroxyanisole.
- 25 (i) Butylated hydroxytoluene.

26 (2) A food establishment that violates subsection (1) is
27 subject to an administrative fine in the Class II category
28 pursuant to s. 570.971 for a first violation. For a second or
29 subsequent violation of subsection (1), such establishment is
30 subject to an administrative fine in the Class III category
31 pursuant to that section.

32 **Section 2.** This act shall take effect July 1, 2025.
