Amendment (with title amendment)

Remove lines 66-108 and insert:

1. A public school may annually request a prescription for glucagon from a county health department or health care provider licensed to issue prescriptions to enable the school to acquire and maintain a supply of undesignated glucagon to treat a student with diabetes who experiences a hypoglycemic emergency or whose prescribed glucagon is not available on site or has expired.

2. A licensed pharmacist may dispense undesignated glucagon pursuant to a prescription in accordance with this paragraph.

17 3. A public school may enter into arrangements with
18 manufacturers of glucagon or other suppliers of glucagon to
19 obtain the products free of charge or at fair market or reduced
20 prices and may obtain monetary donations or apply for grants to
21 purchase glucagon.

22 4. Undesignated glucagon must be stored in a location that
23 is immediately accessible to the school nurse and other school
24 personnel who have been trained to administer glucagon.

25 5. A public school employee or agent trained in the
26 administration of glucagon shall be responsible for the storage,
27 maintenance, and administration of glucagon stocked by a school
28 in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions. Such
29 undesignated glucagon must be authorized and made available by a
30 school for administration to students with diabetes as
31 prescribed in the student's diabetes management plan or health
32 care provider's orders and written accommodations plan.

33 6. Immediately after the administration of undesignated
34 glucagon, a public school employee shall call for emergency
35 assistance and notify a school nurse and the student's parent or
36 guardian or emergency contact.

37 7. A school district and its employees and agents who
38 acquire, maintain, and administer undesignated glucagon, and the
39 undesignated glucagon prescriber or furnisher, are not liable
40 for any injury or loss to person or property which allegedly
41 results from an act or omission associated with procuring,
