A bill to be entitled

An act relating to fees; amending s. 893.1495, F.S.; requiring all covered entities, beginning on a specified date, to pay specified fees to the administrator of the electronic recordkeeping system on a monthly basis; specifying that the administrator is responsible for setting the fees; requiring covered entities to provide certain written documentation to the Department of Law Enforcement upon the department's request; specifying that failure to pay the fees subjects the covered entity to certain criminal penalties; providing a contingent effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Paragraph (d) is added to subsection (5) of section 893.1495, Florida Statutes, as amended in SB 640, 2025 Regular Session, to read:

893.1495 Retail sale of ephedrine and related compounds.—
(5)

- (d)1. Beginning on July 1, 2025, all covered entities must pay on a monthly basis any fees to the administrator of the electronic recordkeeping system for the purpose of supporting the operation of that system in this state.
- 2. The administrator of the electronic recordkeeping system is responsible for setting the fees required for each covered entity under subparagraph 1.
  - 3. Upon the Department of Law Enforcement's request, a

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covered entity must provide written documentation to the department demonstrating that it has paid the fees required under subparagraph 1.

4. The failure of a covered entity to pay the fees required under subparagraph 1. is considered a violation of this section and subjects the covered entity to the penalties in subsection (11).

Section 2. This act shall take effect on the same date that SB 640 or similar legislation takes effect, if such legislation is adopted in the same legislative session or an extension thereof and becomes a law.
