7 (7) (a) For state group health insurance plan policies
8 issued on or after January 1, 2026, the department shall provide
9 coverage of medically necessary expenses relating to standard
10 fertility preservation services when cancer treatments may
11 directly or indirectly cause iatrogenic infertility.

12 (b) Coverage of standard fertility retrieval and
13 preservation services under this subsection includes the costs
14 associated with retrieving and preserving sperm and oocyte
15 materials which are consistent with nationally recognized
16 clinical practice guidelines and definitions. Coverage of

17 retrieval and storage expires after a period of 3 years from the
18 date of the procedures presenting a risk of iatrogenic
19 infertility or when the individual is no longer covered under
20 the state group health insurance plan, whichever occurs first.

21 (c) A state group health insurance plan may not require
22 preauthorization for coverage of standard fertility retrieval
23 and preservation services; however, a health benefit plan may
24 contain provisions for maximum benefits and may subject the
25 covered service to the same deductible, copayment, and
26 coinsurance.

27 (d) As used in this subsection, the term:

28 1. "Iatrogenic infertility" means an impairment of
29 fertility caused directly or indirectly by surgery,
30 chemotherapy, radiation, or other associated medically necessary
31 treatment with a potential side effect of impaired fertility as
32 established by the American Society for Clinical Oncology.

33 2. "Nationally recognized clinical practice guidelines and
34 definitions" mean evidence-based clinical practice guidelines
35 developed by independent organizations or medical professional
36 societies using a transparent methodology and reporting
37 structure and with a conflict-of-interest policy, and
38 definitions used or established in said guidelines. Guidelines
39 developed by such organizations or societies must establish
40 standards of care informed by a systematic review of evidence
41 and an assessment of the benefits and costs of alternative care

42 options and include recommendations intended to optimize patient
43 care.

44 3. "Standard fertility retrieval and preservation
45 services" means oocyte and sperm retrieval and preservation
46 procedures and storage, including ovarian tissue, sperm, and
47 oocyte retrieval and cryopreservation, which are consistent with
48 nationally recognized clinical practice guidelines and
49 definitions.
