

1 A bill to be entitled
2 An act relating to a review under the Open Government
3 Sunset Review Act; amending s. 119.071, F.S., which
4 provides an exemption from public record requirements
5 for certain documents which depict the structural
6 elements of certain 911, E911, or public safety radio
7 communication system infrastructure, structures, or
8 facilities, as well as geographical maps indicating
9 the actual or proposed locations of certain 911, E911,
10 or public safety radio communication infrastructure,
11 structures, or facilities; removing the scheduled
12 repeal of the exemption; amending s. 286.0113, F.S.,
13 which provides an exemption from public meeting
14 requirements for portions of meetings that would
15 reveal certain documents depicting the structural
16 elements of 911, E911, or public safety radio
17 communication system infrastructure, structures, or
18 facilities, or geographical maps indicating the
19 locations or proposed locations of 911, E911, or
20 public safety radio communication system
21 infrastructure, structures, or facilities, as well an
22 exemption from public record requirements for the
23 recording and transcription of the exempt portion of
24 such meetings; removing the scheduled repeal of the
25 exemptions; providing an effective date.

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Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Paragraph (e) of subsection (3) of section 119.071, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

119.071 General exemptions from inspection or copying of public records.—

(3) SECURITY AND FIRESAFETY.—

(e)1.a. Building plans, blueprints, schematic drawings, and diagrams, including draft, preliminary, and final formats, which depict the structural elements of 911, E911, or public safety radio communication system infrastructure, including towers, antennas ~~antennae~~, equipment or facilities used to provide 911, E911, or public safety radio communication services, or other 911, E911, or public safety radio communication structures or facilities owned and operated by an agency are exempt from s. 119.07(1) and s. 24(a), Art. I of the State Constitution.

b. Geographical maps indicating the actual or proposed locations of 911, E911, or public safety radio communication system infrastructure, including towers, antennas ~~antennae~~, equipment or facilities used to provide 911, E911, or public safety radio services, or other 911, E911, or public safety radio communication structures or facilities owned and operated by an agency are exempt from s. 119.07(1) and s. 24(a), Art. I

52 | 2. This exemption applies to building plans, blueprints,
53 | schematic drawings, and diagrams, including draft, preliminary,
54 | and final formats, which depict the structural elements of 911,
55 | E911, or public safety radio communication system infrastructure
56 | or other 911, E911, or public safety radio communication
57 | structures or facilities owned and operated by an agency, and
58 | geographical maps indicating actual or proposed locations of
59 | 911, E911, or public safety radio communication system
60 | infrastructure or other 911, E911, or public safety radio
61 | communication structures or facilities owned and operated by an
62 | agency, before, on, or after the effective date of this act.

63 | 3. Information made exempt by this paragraph may be
64 | disclosed:

65 | a. To another governmental entity if disclosure is
66 | necessary for the receiving entity to perform its duties and
67 | responsibilities;

68 | b. To a licensed architect, engineer, or contractor who is
69 | performing work on or related to the 911, E911, or public safety
70 | radio communication system infrastructure, including towers,
71 | antennas ~~antennae~~, equipment or facilities used to provide 911,
72 | E911, or public safety radio communication services, or other
73 | 911, E911, or public safety radio communication structures or
74 | facilities owned and operated by an agency; or

75 | c. Upon a showing of good cause before a court of

76 competent jurisdiction.

77 4. The entities or persons receiving such information must
78 maintain the exempt status of the information.

79 5. For purposes of this paragraph, the term "public safety
80 radio" is defined as the means of communication between and
81 among 911 public safety answering points, dispatchers, and first
82 responder agencies using those portions of the radio frequency
83 spectrum designated by the Federal Communications Commission
84 under 47 C.F.R. part 90 for public safety purposes.

87 on October 2, 2025, unless reviewed and saved from repeal
