Section 16. Section 106.151, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

106.151 Use of public funds prohibited.—Public funds may not be used to advocate for or against any matter that is the subject of an amendment or a revision to the State Constitution, regardless of whether the amendment or revision was proposed by

14 prohibition includes the use of state funds to publish,
15 broadcast, or disseminate public service messages concerning an
