18 (3) Information provided to parents and guardians shall
19 include, but not be limited to, all of the following:

20 (a) A description of Type 1 diabetes.

21 (b) A description of the risk factors and warning signs
22 associated with Type 1 diabetes.

23 (c) A description of the process for screening students
24 for early detection of Type 1 diabetes using a blood
25 autoantibody test.

26 (d) A recommendation for further evaluation for students
27 displaying warning signs associated with Type 1 diabetes or
28 positive early detection screening results.

29 **Section 2. Subsection (5) of section 1002.53, Florida**
30 **Statutes, is amended to read:**

31 1002.53 Voluntary Prekindergarten Education Program;
32 eligibility and enrollment.—

33 (5) The early learning coalition shall provide each parent
34 enrolling a child in the Voluntary Prekindergarten Education
35 Program with a profile of every private prekindergarten provider
36 and public school delivering the program within the county where
37 the child is being enrolled. The profiles shall be provided to
38 parents in a format prescribed by the department in accordance
39 with s. 1002.92(3). The early learning coalition must also
40 annually notify parents and guardians of the availability of
