Section 125.5695, Florida Statutes, is created 15 to read: 16 125.5695 Standards for sanitary and storm water systems.-17 (1) All sanitary and storm water systems, including 18 laterals, sewer pipe, storm pipe, and manhole covers in counties 19 in this state, when installing new or repairing existing 20 laterals, sewer pipe, storm pipe, and manhole covers, must 21 follow the annual state Department of Transportation's Standard 22 Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction contained in the 23 sections "Pipe Culverts" and "Pipe Liner." 24 (2) All final inspections for all laterals, sewer pipe, 25 storm pipe, and manhole covers in counties must be performed by

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26	a licensed engineer, general contractor, or third party
27	inspection company that is not the current licensed operator for
28	the job being inspected.
29	(3) The standards for installation and inspection in
30	subsections (1) and (2) supersede all existing and local

35	(1) All sanitary and storm water systems, including

50	Section 3. Pursuant to s. 18, Art. VII of the State
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51	Constitution, the Legislature hereby determines and declares
52	that this act fulfills an important state interest.
53	Section 4. This act shall take effect July 1, 2025.

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
